

OBJECTIVES

- 1. To provide students with an advanced specialist and multidisciplinary training, aimed at professional specialisation or research in the field of language assessment and literary culture in the Catalan language.
- 2. To equip students with general and specific skills which will enable them to apply their training to professional contexts related to their area of study.
- 3. To introduce students to the tools and knowledge necessary to develop their critical faculties and capacity for analysis and synthesis, in order to integrate knowledge and be able to reflect and decide on topics related to language assessment and literary culture, but also on topics of a social, scientific and ethical nature.
- 4. To equip students with the ability to transmit information, ideas and the conclusions of their observations or research clearly and unambiguously.
- 5. To introduce students to the tools and knowledge, and their applications, that will enable them to develop the skills necessary for independent learning and for professional practice or research in the field of language assessment and literary culture.

GENERAL COURSE PROGRAMME

The Master in Linguistics and Literary Culture Consulting: Applications to Context Valenciano is organized in three modules of 30, 35 and 10 credits, teaching each of which will be distributed in semesters.

- · Module 1 consists of 30 common credit.
- Module 2 (35 credits): Students must choose one of two tracks of specialization:
 - · Route A: Applications and research in the cultural and educational context.
 - · Route B: Applications and research in public administration and in publishing companies.



- · Work experience.
- · Research training.
- · Module 3, students will have to make a final master work (10 credits).

Module 1

The common module 1 or module, which will be held in the first half of the first year, consists of three subjects of 10 credits:

- · Language skills and technologies for language assessment.
- · In-depth historical and cultural studies.
- · Multilingualism and multiculturality.

Module 2

- Route A: "Applications and research in the cultural and educational context." This route of module 2 is specified in three subjects of 10 credits each, which will be taught in the second semester of the first year:
 - · Speaking and writing: analysis and production.
 - · Literary culture and teaching.
 - · Resources and materials for language teaching and learning.
- Route B: "Applications and research in government and publishing." This route of module 2 is specified in three subjects of 10 credits each, which will be taught in the second semester of the first year:
 - · Language services.
 - · Specialization in text editing.
 - · Specialist translation and new technologies.
- · Work experience (5 credits).
- · Research training (5 credits).

The two orientations are taught in the first semester of the second year.

Module 3

Final dissertation (10 credits) to be performed on the first and second semester of the second year.

ENTRY REQUIREMENTS

According to the Regulations of the University of Alicante, the following requirements must be complied to have access to official taught Master's degrees:

- 1. To be in possession of a SPANISH OFFICIAL GRADUATE DEGREE CERTIFICATE or other issued by an institution of higher education within the <u>EHEA</u> (European Higher Education) that enables the holder to have access to Master's degrees in the issuing.
- 2. To be in possession of an officially approved FOREIGN HIGHER EDUCATION DEGREE CERTIFICATE that had been recognised as equal to the degree that allows access to the requested studies.
- 3. To be in possession of a UNIVERSITY DEGREE CERTIFICATE obtained in a University or Higher Education Institution of COUNTRIES OUTSIDE THE EHEA, without the prior approval of their studies. In this case, the following should be considered:
 - Non- recognised degree certificates shall require a technical report showing an equivalence statement issued by the University of Alicante (ContinUA Continuing Education Centre), for which the corresponding fee should be paid.
 - Access through this way does under no circumstances imply prior official approval of the holder's degree certificate, nor its recognition for purposes other than studying a master's degree.

ADMISSION AND ASSESSMENT CRITERIA

1.-Admission profile

The applicant profile considered suitable for admission to this Master's Degree is as follows:

- University degree holders who have successfully completed a higher education course in areas related to the Master's Degree, or who have a professional
 profile related to the course programme (Language and Literature, Translation and Interpreting, Humanities, Audiovisual Communication, Journalism,
 Teaching or Librarianship and Archives).
- Professional practice in the areas of specialisation covered in the Master's Degree (secondary education, language and cultural assessment, language promotion, editing, translation, librarianship, etc.)

Applicants who wish to study this Master's Degree will be required to provide evidence of level CI (or above) command of Catalan, both written and oral

Specific admission requirements:

Applicants who do not hold a degree in Catalan Language and Literature will be required to provide proof of a command of Catalan equivalent to level C1 or above (Diploma in Teaching in the Valencian language or Certificate of Proficiency in the Valencian language, issued by the Valencian Government, Intermediate Level Catalan, issued by the University of Valencia, Intermediate Level, issued by the Valencian Language Qualifications Board, or equivalent qualifications from other governmental or officially recognised academic organisations)

2. Assessment criteria

The Master's Academic Committee will be responsible for implementing the student admission procedure and for resolving any issues arising from the selection process.

Given that this Master's Degree primarily aimed at two different groups, two admission routes are offered:

- via a university qualification
- · via professional practice

Pre-enrolment applications should be accompanied by accreditation of professional practice, detailing length of service, or previous university qualification, together with a full academic record.

Following the pre-enrolment period, if demand exceeds the number of places available, applications will be subject to ranking in order of preference.

In this case, admission criteria will be weighted as follows:

CURRENT PROFESSIONAL PRACTICE 30% OF PLACES

 State employees, whether holding permanent, provisional or temporary positions, (in the areas of secondary education in language and literature, language assessment, translation,



	editing or primary school teaching): 3 points.
	 Self-employed professionals who can provide accreditation of professional practice related to any of the specialisations: 2 points.
	 Other professionals in related areas: 1 point.
	In each of these sub-groups, every five-year period of professional practice will be worth an additional 2 points.
UNIVERSITY QUALIFICATION 70% OF PLACES	1- Doctorate in the areas or qualifications mentioned above: 6 points.
	 2- Postgraduate students in the areas or qualifications mentioned above: 5 points.
	 3- Degree in Catalan Language and Literature or Spanish Language and Literature (specialisation: Valencian Language and Literature): 4 points.
	 4- Degree in other Languages and Literatures, Translation and Interpreting, Humanities, Audiovisual Communication, Journalism and Teaching: 3 points.
	 5- Diploma or Degree in Primary School Teaching or Librarianship and Archives: 2 points.
	6- Other degrees or diplomas: 1 point.
	Within each sub-group, applicants will be given preference according to grades obtained for academic achievement.



Advanced specialist training aimed at professional specialisation and/or introduction to research in the field of Catalan Language and Literature.

DEGREE COURSE SPECIALISATION PROFILE

This Master's Degree is aimed at training professionals (language technicians, translators, assessors, editors and proofreaders, literary critics, etc.) in the field of the language and culture industries and in particular, in the field of publishing, permitting the dissemination of foreign literary works and the publication of materials aimed at language teaching in the target language.

1. Timescale for implementation of the new Master's Degree Course

The complete Master's Degree course programme will be implemented in one phase. This does not imply that those students who wish to conclude their studies on the present Master's course will be unable to do so: the necessary measures will be taken to guarantee teaching of the current Master's Degree subjects.

2. Equivalence Recognition Procedures, where appropriate, between the current and the new course programme.

To facilitate the transition from the present Master's Degree course to the new course programme, information sessions have been held the 2009-2010 enrolment period, to assist students with guidance as regards enrolment and enable them to transfer with ease to the new course programme.

Credits which have been successfully completed on the present course programme will be given equivalence on the new Master's Degree course according to the credit equivalence table shown below:


